	TITLE: Transfer Station Policy	Department: Public Works

PURPOSE: The purpose of this policy shall be to ensure the Town of Carman disposes of all materials in the most environmentally conscious manner.

RATIONALE: To establish guidelines for all items brought to the transfer station so that they are sorted by the delivering party and placed in the area designated for such material.

POLICY STATEMENT: The Town of Carman owns and operates a Transfer Station that is in the RM of Dufferin. The main purpose of this Transfer Station is to provide environmentally conscious disposal for waste items.

ADMINISTRATION AND PROCEDURES:

The Town of Carman staff cannot accept tipping fees for items that should be recycled, burnt or repurposed. Tipping fees are charged only for items that cannot be recycled or repurposed and must be hauled to an authorized landfill. Any person bringing waste to the transfer station and refusing to sort their material will be refused disposal rights.

The Transfer Station accepts the following materials – Paper, cardboard, tin cans and metals, appliances, light bulbs, e-waste, paints, aerosol cannisters, propane bottles, tires, aluminum beverage containers, plastic, compost items, clean wood, glass, used oil, filters, antifreeze, and household waste. Designated areas have been developed within the Transfer Station for accepting each material.

Tipping fees will be reviewed and implemented at the discretion of the Council of the Town of Carman.
