

**TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 19/2041**

BEING a By-law of the Town of Carman to set
Reduced Speed School Zones in the Town of Carman.

WHEREAS Section 98.1 of the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013 authorize a council to pass by-laws establishing the reduced maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven on a highway within a school zone within the geographic boundaries of a municipality; and

WHEREAS the Town of Carman deems it advisable and in the best interests of the Town to establish school zones with a reduced maximum speed for vehicles; now

THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Carman, in Council duly assembled, enacts a by-law as follows:

1. This By-law may be called the “Reduced-Speed School Zone By-law”.

Interpretation

2. For the purposes of this By-law, “highway”, “reduced-speed school zone”, “school”, “school property”, “traffic control device”, and “vehicle” have the same meanings as set out in the Highway Traffic Act and the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.

Establishment of reduced-speed school zones

3. The following portions of highways are designated as reduced-speed school zones with reduced maximum permitted speed:
 - a) **Carman Elementary School**, 156 – 2nd Street SW – Provincial Road #245
 - i) That portion of Provincial Road #245 commencing at the junction of 1st Street SW and 4th Avenue SW (PR #245) and continue west past the elementary school for 150 m to the entrance of the Boyne Lodge; and
 - b) **Carman Collegiate**, 121-4th Avenue SE – Provincial Trunk Highway #3
 - i) That portion of Provincial Truck Highway #3 commencing 170 metres west of the Town’s eastern boundary and continue west on 4th Avenue SE (Provincial Truck Highway #3) for 395 metres.

Maximum permitted speed within reduced-speed school zones

4. The maximum permitted speed for vehicles being driven in a reduced-speed school zone on a highway is 30 km/h.

Times when the reduced-speed school zones apply

5. The reduced maximum permitted speeds established under section 4 apply within a reduced-speed school zone 08:00 to 17:30, Monday to Friday from September 1 through to and including June 30.

Traffic control devices

6. The Town of Carman shall identify a reduced-speed school zone with traffic control devices that comply with the Reduced-Speed School Zones Regulation No. 136/2013.

Enactment

7. THAT By-law No. 13/1981 shall be repealed.
8. THAT this by-law shall come into full force and take effect upon the passing of it.
